


# MAP OF SUGAR GROVE TOWNSHIP

### HISTORICAL.

The first settlements were made in this Township in May, 1834, by Jas. Isbell, Chauncy Isbell, Asa McDole, and James Carmon. P. Y. Bliss, one of the pioneers of this Township, erected a Store where his residence now stands, and for several years supplied his neighbors with goods.
